NEWS FROM THE TEXTBOOK ROOM:

I noticed last year that a large majority of students were not covering their books and this has really taken a toll on the book's wear and tear. I also discovered that the cloth book covers are worse for the books than to use nothing at all. In order to put the covers on and off, the front and back covers must be bent back, which weakens the spine. They also do not support the spine or the book corners.

Please encourage your students to cover their books with PAPER. I have book

covers here in the Textbook Room, or a brown paper sack cover has worked best for generations. I am always more than happy to help the students cover their books.

Again, I would like you to discourage the students from using the cloth covers. They look pretty but do not protect the books.
